

1. Flight Planning Information

- Airport Information www.SLR.aero
- **NOTAM WILL BE PUBLISHED ON 29 MARCH**
(Once the NOTAM is published... It will be posted here.)
- **ALL ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES BETWEEN 5 APRIL AND 9 APRIL WILL REQUIRE PRIOR PERMISSION**
- PPR (Prior Permission Required) will be issued and emailed to you by the Airport office. PPR must be printed and placed on the right side of the aircraft windscreen. Aircraft arriving after 4 April without a PPR will not be allowed to park.

- There will be an **Event Fee** charged for aircraft arriving at KSLR for the Eclipse Event. A **Credit Card Authorization Form** must accompany all applications for PPR. The fee will be assessed when the PPR is issued and is non-refundable. PPRs will be issued beginning 15 March.
Cancellation of the PPR request must be received by midnight on 14 March.
 - \$150.00 for aircraft under 6000 lbs MLW
 - \$300.00 for aircraft 6000–12000 lbs MLW
 - \$450.00 for aircraft over 12000 lbs MLW
- There will be a minimum of 4 pairs of Eclipse Safety Glasses issued with each PPR. Additional glasses will be available for \$2.00 each.
- On 8 April, beginning at **11:30 LOCAL**, 1 hour prior to the start of the eclipse, and **15:30 LOCAL**, 30 minutes after the eclipse, **the runway will be closed to all arrival and departing traffic**
- Please bring chocks, there may not be access to anchor points on paved parking areas.
- If the weather allows, many parking locations will be off-pavement, you must have your own tie-down straps and anchor points.
- We recommend that you bring your own chairs. You can sit at/near your plane or at the terminal building. There will be limited seating available on site. No one will be allowed on the runway or taxiways.
- Power for personal equipment (computers, iPads, cameras, etc.) will be limited and available on a first-come basis.
- Camping on the field will be allowed in designated areas and only for those flying in for the eclipse. Dry camping only, additional details are listed under **Camping** below.
- There will be food trucks on the Airport from **6 April – 8 April**. Local EAA Chapter 1094 will have drinks and snacks available for purchase.
- The **Red Barn Café** will be open during the following times: **CASH ONLY**
 - Friday 5 April 07:00–21:00 CDT
 - Saturday 6 April 07:00–14:00 CDT
 - Sunday 7 April CLOSED
 - Monday 8 April 07:00–14:00 CDT
- There will be portable restrooms at the airport. **No Showers will be available.**

3. **Arrival Information:** Upon arrival communicate with the aircraft parking team via radio on **121.9**. After securing your aircraft, check in with the parking team or at the terminal building.

4. **Parking:** Beginning on 5 April, all arriving and departing aircraft must have a PPR. Aircraft without a PPR will not be allowed to park or remain for the event. The printed PPR must be displayed on the right side of the windscreen of your aircraft and be easily viewable. PPR will be distributed by the Airport office via email. **Contact the Parking Teams on 121.9.**

- A parking diagram will be posted on 1 April.

5. Fueling

- **Self Service and Full Service fueling will be available.**
- **There may be extended wait-times for fuel.**

6. Departure Information

- There will be parking team volunteers all around the Airport to assist with your departure. Please follow their directions to help expedite departures and manage traffic in a safe and orderly manner. **The Ramp Boss will be the overall ground authority.**
- All aircraft should plan to depart VFR (If an IFR clearance is required, contact Fort Worth Center/ARTCC once airborne).
- Intersection takeoffs **will not** be permitted.

7. Ground Transportation

- Courtesy vehicles will not be available on 8 April.
- Ground Transportation options to off-airport locations will be limited and likely not available on 8 April.

8. Camping

- **Camping on the airport property will be allowed from 6 April – 8 April**
- Dry Camping only.
- No fires will be permitted.
- There will be portable Restrooms at the airport.
- **No Showers will be available.**
